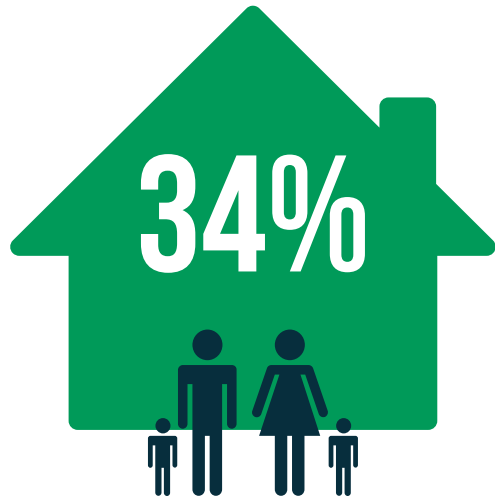

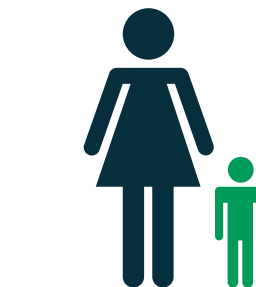

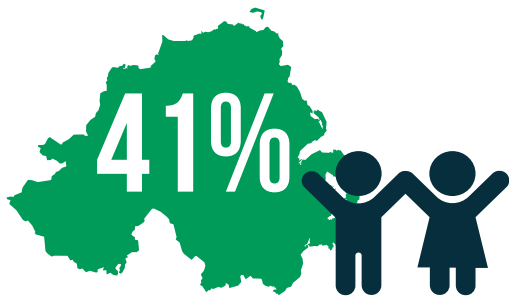

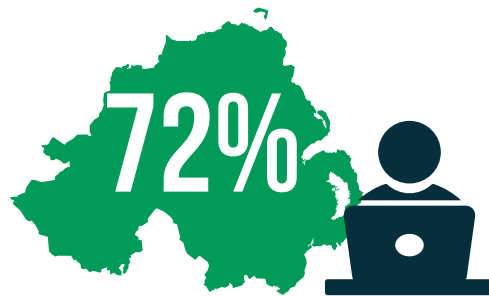

THIS SHOWS HOW DIFFICULT CHILDCARE HAS BEEN FOR SOME WITH LOCKDOWN PREVENTING ACCESS BETWEEN HOUSEHOLDS AND FAMILIES NOT WANTING TO EXPOSE GRANDPARENTS TO THE VIRUS.
